This was the 3rd annual event for commemorating and celebrating Earth Day in East Honolulu. In addition to Hawaii Kai residents, this year's clean up was participated in by the Hawaii Kai Boy Scouts and Whiskers the Dog.

While large rusty nails from burned pallets and broken beer bottles were the most prominent hazards on the beach, overall the Ka Iwi shoreline was found to be in a cleaner state than it was in previous years.
