It was part of an open house organized by the Kamilonui Farmers' co-op. The goal, to show visitors the beauty of Hawaii Kai's agricultural lands and drum up support before the farmers enter rent negotiations with landowner Kamehameha schools.

"Obviously going to go up. We've been here for about 40 years now. So it's going to go up. But how high, we don't know," said Glenn Nii.

The valley has 87 acres of farmland. Glenn Nii says if the rent increase is too steep, the farmers will be forced to shut down operations.
